

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 20489**

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Eastman Chemical Company (CN601214406) has submitted an application for the renewal/amendment of permit number 20489. The Olefins Process Water Unit (RN10219815) receives and treats process water at 300 Kodak Blvd, Longview, Harrison County.

This renewal/amendment will authorize the continued operation of all facilities and activities conducted by the Olefins Process Water Unit. Eastman has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

Pollutant	Proposed Emissions (tons per year)
Nitrogen Oxides (NO _x)	2.01
Carbon Monoxide (CO)	7.96
Organic Compounds (VOC)	28.15
Sulfur Dioxide (SO ₂)	0.08

The facilities being renewed continue to be controlled by leak detection and repair (LDAR) programs, a flare, and a process water stripper.
