

Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Amendment Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 16963

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

REXtac, LLC (CN603530866) has submitted an application for renewal of and amendment to permit number 16963. The Odessa Plant (RN103719704) produces/manufactures APAO at 2501 S. Grandview Avenue, Odessa, Ector County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of the APAO manufacturing units. The amendment will update representations to the process and the consolidation of Permits by Rule that have been previously authorized will authorize facilities under the permit. REXtac, LLC has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities being renewed and the new and/or modified facilities are controlled by dust collectors/filters to control process vent emissions, covered and enclosed transfer systems, tank designs such as size, color and the use of best practices, routine operator inspections to check piping components for leaks, use of pipeline-quality natural gas fuel, good combustion practices, and good operating and maintenance practices.
