

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal
Amendment Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 20283**

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Natural Gas Pipeline Company of America LLC (CN600124200) has submitted an application for renewal of and amendment to Permit Number 20283. Compressor Station 802 (RN100220987) is a natural gas pipeline compressor station located at latitude 33° 31' 12" and longitude -95° 38' 10", near Paris, Texas in Lamar County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of natural gas compressor engines, heaters, supporting storage tanks, truck loading of waste liquids such as used oils and wastewater, an emergency generator, and associated fugitive components. The amendment will authorize the change in calculation methodology in AP-42 Chapter 7.1 for storage tank emissions, remove several pieces of equipment no longer at the site or currently operating with no emissions. Finally, the amendment will correct typographical errors and remove references to equipment no longer in service in the special conditions. Natural Gas Pipeline Company of America LLC has listed in its application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities being renewed are controlled by lean operation of the natural gas compressor engines. The new and/or modified facilities do not include any proposed control.
