

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 5955A**

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Delek Refining, Ltd. (CN602831232) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 5955A. The Tyler Refinery (RN100222512) produces/manufactures Petroleum Refining at 1701 Commerce Street, Tyler, Smith County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of Sulfur Recovery Plant. Delek Refining, Ltd. has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities being renewed continue to be controlled by SCOT Unit and 75% redundancy.
