

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number
19430**

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Conecsus, LLC (CN CN604058693) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 19430. The Conecsus Tejas Facility (RN RN100804467) is a pyrometallurgical recycling plant at 106 Tejas Drive, Terrell, Texas, Kaufman County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of recovery of tin, lead and precious metals from materials such as tin and tin/lead drosses, filtercakes, by-products, sludges, baghouse dusts and contaminated pastes and wipes. Conecsus, LLC has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities being renewed continue to be controlled by baghouses and scrubber stacks.
