

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Initial
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 182636**

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Martin Marietta Texas Ready-Mix, LLC (CN606115699) has submitted an application for initial permit number 182636. The Randolph Ready Mix Plant (RN111389730) produces concrete at 9111 S Highway 121, Trenton, Fannin County.

This permit will authorize an existing concrete batch plant with maximum production of 300 cubic yards per hour and 300,000 cubic yards per year of concrete and operate up to 8,760 hours per year. Martin Marietta Texas Ready-Mix, LLC has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facility will be controlled by paved roads, watered stockpiles, and dust collectors for the truck drop point, weigh hopper, and silos.
