

Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal and Amendment Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 19875

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Holly Energy Partners - Operating, LP (CN602777476) has submitted an application for renewal and amendment of Permit Number 19875. The Abilene Bulk Fuels Terminal (RN102170412) produces/manufactures bulk fuels at 3.7 miles west of the Interstate Highway 20 and Highway 277 intersection, then from exit 278 going toward BL/Tye, continuing west on Interstate Highway 20 Frontage Road/West Overland Trail for 1.5 miles, turn left and proceed south on Interstate Highway 20 BL for 0.3 mile, turning left onto North Street, continuing to 1000 South Service Road, Tye, Taylor County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of the Abilene Bulk Fuels Terminal. Existing permits by rule and standard permits are being incorporated for changes to storage tanks since the last renewal. In addition, the tank emission calculations and flare SO₂ emissions estimates are being updated to utilize current EPA guidance. Holly Energy Partners - Operating, LP - has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The loading rack will continue to be controlled by the flare when loading gasoline or transmix.
