

Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Amendment Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 6348

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

NuStar Logistics, L.P. (CN603180662) has submitted an application for renewal of and amendment to permit number 6348. The San Antonio Refined Products Terminal South (RN102310901) is a bulk gasoline terminal for finished petroleum products. The site is located at 10619 S US Highway 281, San Antonio, Bexar County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of various fixed roof tanks, internal floating roof tanks, an oil water separator, a truck loading rack, a vapor combustion unit, and fugitive emissions. The amendment will authorize changes to these facilities. NuStar Logistics, L.P. has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The storage tank emissions will be controlled by internal floating roof or submerged loading tanks. Fugitive emissions will be controlled by monthly inspections. Loading emissions will be controlled by a vapor combustion unit.
