

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Amendment
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 20275**

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Delek Marketing & Supply, LP (CN 603169509) has submitted an application for renewal of and amendment to permit number 20275. The San Angelo Terminal (RN 102417003) receives, stores, and distributes a variety of petroleum liquids at 4008 N US Highway 67, San Angelo, Tom Green County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of tank and loading operations with associated controls. The amendment will authorize updated representations for the tank seals and fittings. Delek Marketing & Supply, LP has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities being renewed are controlled by proper equipment design and operation including floating roof tanks with seal systems, submerged loading, use of a combustion control device, utilization of good combustion practices, and implementation of a leak detection and repair program. The new and/or modified facilities will be controlled by proper equipment design and operation including floating roof tanks with seal systems.
