

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 56481**

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Magellan Pipeline Terminals, L.P (CN603167297) has submitted the application for renewal of permit number 56481. The Dallas Terminal (RN100242015) receives and stores bulk petroleum products at 4200 Singleton Blvd, Dallas, Dallas County.

The renewal will authorize the continued operation of the Dallas Terminal to receive and store petroleum products for pipeline or truck delivery.

The renewal will consolidate other existing authorizations (previously authorized permits by rule permits) into permit number 56481.

Magellan Pipeline Terminals, L.P has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities continue to be controlled by emission control devices such as floating roofs, a vapor recovery unit and vapor combustion unit.
