

Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Amendment Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 18478

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application

L3Harris Technologies Integrated Systems L.P. (CN600440390) has submitted an application for renewal of and amendment to permit number 18478. Majors Field (RN100753755) refurbishes and performs maintenance on aircraft at 10001 Jack Finney Blvd, Greenville, Hunt County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of operations related to aircraft maintenance and refurbishing, including but not limited to: parts stripping, cleaning, metal finishing, painting, and electronics replacements and upgrades. The amendment will authorize a new paint booth. L3Harris Technologies Integrated Systems L.P. has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.
