

Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Amendment Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 588

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Midcoast G&P (East Texas) L.P. (CN603573817) has submitted an application for an amendment to permit number 588. The Avinger Gas Processing Plant (RN102735800) produces/manufactures propane, butane, natural gasoline, and condensate at 2339 Avinger Cut-Off Road, Avinger, Marion County.

This amendment will authorize new operating scenarios; updates to stream data, calculation methodologies, and emission factors; and incorporation by consolidation of the flare, currently authorized under non-rule Air Quality Standard Permit for Pollution Control Projects #149755, which was originally authorized in the NSR.

Midcoast G&P (East Texas) L.P. has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.
