

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 19425**

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Storopack, Inc. (CN603482316) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 19425. The Storopack Dallas (RN101964849) produces/manufactures Polystyrene Packaging at 5050 Duncanville Rd., Dallas, Dallas County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of the Expanded Polystyrene Packaging Manufacturing equipment and process. Storopack, Inc. has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

Pollutant	Proposed Emissions (tons per year)
VOC	24.9

The facilities being renewed continue to be controlled by a limited operating schedule of 6,240 hours per year, limits to the expanders feed rate, limits to the maximum annual polystyrene feed rate, limits to the maximum percentage of pentane blowing agent that is impregnated in the polystyrene bead, limits the total number of expanders in operation at the facility, and a facility VOC emission Cap.
