

Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Amendment Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 1659

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Huber Carbonates, LLC (CN604710210) has submitted an application for renewal of and amendment to permit number 1659. The Limestone Crushing facility (RN100728732) produces/manufactures calcium carbonate (limestone) at 90 Avenue N, Marble Falls, Burnet County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of the limestone processing facility including grinding mills, silos, bagging operations, material handling operations, roads, and a hot oil preheater. The amendment will authorize updates to representations associated with equipment at the facility to reflect the current and proposed operations, add new/upgraded equipment at the plant and authorize speciated particulate matter emissions. Huber Carbonates LLC has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities being renewed continue to be controlled by dust collectors that remove particulate matter. The new and/or modified facilities will be controlled by dust collectors that remove particulate matter or are housed in an enclosed structure to contain particulate matter.
