

Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 2085

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

UTEX Industries, Inc. (CN605855188) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 2085. The UTEX Weimar Plant (RN101520989) produces/manufactures Rubber Packing, Gasket and Seals at 605 Utex Drive, Weimar, Colorado County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of a cloth drying tower, batch mixer, vent and window fugitives, processing losses, a surface coating spray hood, and two dust collectors. UTEX Industries, Inc. has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

Volatile organic compounds (VOC)	6.31
Particulate matter (PM)	1.19
Particulate matter including particulate matter with diameters of 10 microns or less (PM ₁₀)	1.19
Particulate matter including particulate matter with diameters of 2.5 microns or less (PM _{2.5})	1.19
Exempt Solvents	0.01
Hazardous air pollutants (HAPs)	2.10

The facilities being renewed continue to be controlled by utilizing best practices to minimize emissions, storage of solvents in closed containers, use of high transfer efficiency spray coating equipment, and use of dust collectors where applicable.
