

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Initial
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 183672 and N332**

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Mustang Express Pipeline, LLC (CN606498806) has submitted an application for initial permit number 183672 and N332. The Katy Compressor Station (RN112426689) will produce/manufacture Pipeline Natural Gas at 29.82589, -95.886197, Katy, Waller County.

This permit will authorize [the Katy Compressor Station which receives natural gas which it then processes through 4 Solar Titan Compressors before it exits the site via pipeline . *Mustang Express* has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The new facilities will be controlled by *an SCR system on the Solar Titan Turbines, the use of pipeline quality natural gas, and good operating practices.*
